

Arizona Department of Education Move On When Reading February 2019

DIBELS and Acadience Reading Guidance

The lawsuit between University of Oregon and Dynamic Measurement Group (DMG) was recently settled. The settlement resulted in some changes that will impact all users of DIBELS 6th edition, DIBELS Next, and DIBELS 8th edition moving forwards.

The following document provides information about both vendors and programs as of February 2019. If more information is provided in the coming months, some gaps in the information will be filled.

Per Arizona law, the Arizona Department of Education is prohibited from endorsing vendor products. This guidance document provides information on the two vendors, but it does not recommend one program over another. It is incumbent upon each school and district to use the information to determine its plan moving forward.

Changes to DIBELS and Acadience Reading

DIBELS was developed at the University of Oregon by Dr. Roland Good and Dr. Ruth Kaminski. In 2018, a lawsuit between DMG and University of Oregon resulted in changes to the DIBELS brand of assessments.

Following the settlement, the DIBELS brand is now owned by the University of Oregon. The University of Oregon supports DIBELS 6th and DIBELS 8th editions and further editions moving forward. The University of Oregon will support DIBELS Next through the 2019-2020 school year.

Following the settlement, DMG retained control of the DIBELS Next assessment and changed its name to Acadience Reading.

There will be a two-year transition period where University of Oregon will continue to support DIBELS Next. DMG will support DIBELS Next, under the name Acadience Reading, indefinitely.

Below is information provided to the Arizona Department of Education by DMG, University of Oregon, and Amplify.

Dynamic Measurement Group

- 1. **Product**: Acadience Reading (Formerly DIBELS Next)
 - a. Acadience Reading is the new name for DIBELS Next.
 - b. The Acadience Reading assessment is the same as DIBELS Next; only the name has changed.
 - c. Acadience Reading assesses students from pre-K to 9th grade.
 - d. Acadience Reading has a dyslexia screening option available.

2. Benchmark Goals

- a. The benchmark goals for DIBELS Next will remain the same under Acadience Reading.
- b. District, student and grade-level reports will remain consistent between DIBELS Next and Acadience Reading.

3. Data

- a. Historical DIBELS Next data from previous years will continue to be available to users of Acadience Reading.
- b. Acadience Reading (DIBELS Next) and DIBELS 6th edition data can be entered in the Acadience Data Management system (formerly DIBELSnet).
 - i. The Acadience Data Management system will also contain historical DIBELS Next data.
 - ii. Data that currently lives in a data system other than the Acadience Data Management system can be imported at no cost.
- c. Acadience Reading (formerly DIBELS Next) data can continue to be entered in the DIBELS Data System, which is owned by the University of Oregon, through the 2019-2020 school year. However, after that school year, the University of Oregon's DIBELS Data System will only accept data from DIBELS 8th edition.

- a. Paper/Pencil
 - i. Acadience Reading is available for free PDF download from Dynamic Measurement Group at https://acadiencelearning.org.
- b. Mobile Administration
 - i. Amplify will continue to support mCLASS:DIBELS Next for current users (users who purchased it before June 30, 2019) through the 2020-2021 school year.
 - 1. After the 2020-2021 school year, Amplify will only support mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition, published by the University of Oregon.
 - ii. Information about the mobile delivery for Acadience Reading after the 2020-2021 school year is not available at this time. However, per DMG, the company is currently actively pursuing electronic delivery options for Acadience Reading.

University of Oregon

- 1. **Products**: DIBELS 6th and 8th Edition
 - a. The University of Oregon owns and supports DIBELS 6th and 8th editions.
 - i. The University of Oregon will continue to support DIBELS Next (Acadience Reading) through the 2019-2020 school year.
 - b. DIBELS 8th edition assesses students from kindergarten to 8th grade.
 - c. DIBELS 8th is being validated as a dyslexia screener.

2. Benchmark Goals

- a. The benchmark goals for DIBELS 8th edition are different from DIBELS Next. DIBELS 8th edition has new measures with new benchmarks.

- a. DIBELS 6th, DIBELS Next, and DIBELS 8th edition data are available through the DIBELS Data System.
 - i. Historical DIBELS Next data from previous years will continue to be available to users of DIBELS 8th edition.
- b. Acadience Reading (formerly DIBELS Next) data can continue to be entered in the DIBELS Data System, which is owned by the University of Oregon, through the 2019-2020 school year. However, after that school year, the DIBELS Data System will only accept data from DIBELS 8th edition.
- c. Data that currently lives in a data system other than the DIBELS Data System can be exported into the DIBELS Data System at no cost.

 - i. DIBELS 8^{th} edition can be delivered through Amplify's mCLASS platform starting in 2019-2020.
 - ii. Amplify will continue to support mCLASS:DIBELS Next for current users (users who purchased it before June 30, 2019) through the 2020-2021 school year.
 - 1. After the 2020-2021 school year, Amplify will only support mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition.
