Additional Considerations	 Failure to meet the annual training requirement can result in the LEA/charter being put on programmatic hold the following year. Administrators are welcome to attend days 2-4 of New Officer or New CSW Training with their SRO, JPOs, and CSWs if seats are available. Site Administrator: This is the school principal or a designee (assistant principal, dean of students, etc.), whomever works most directly with the SSP-funded position (school resource officer, juvenile probation officer, school social worker, school counselor) and is primarily responsible for the implementation of the program. If a principal appoints a designee (assistant principal, dean of students, etc.) as the site administrator to oversee the School Safety Program, both the principal and the designee must attend Leadership 100. Thereafter, the designee can attend SSP Advanced University Course on behalf of the principal. If there is 	

	turnover in either position, the continuing administrator must ensure that the current year's training requirement is met. The new administrator must attend Leadership 100. If you are a returning position and have not attended SSP training for the last two school years, you are required to take the new position training (L100, New Officer training, or New CSW training) again, as the training content may have changed substantially.
