Check your SPED72 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The SPED72 report will show all students reported to AzEDS with SPED needs and/or SPED Program participation, ELL participation, and whether they have passed FED SPED and State SPED integrity.

Check your INTEG15 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The INTEG15 report displays a post-integrity list of student data related to membership and their integrity status results. Drill down using the filters to identify students at a specific site (optional), Integrity Status as 'Failed,' and Integrity Category of 'SPED' and 'Fed SPED.'

Integrity Error -40055 (1 of 2)

- Error Message
 - Invalid exit code combination; refer to the SPED Exit Validation matrix.
- Common Issues
 - After May 1
 - Invalid combination of exit reasons are entered for SPED and Enrollment.
- Possible Solution
 - Review <u>SPED Exit Validation Matrix</u> and correct one or both exit reasons.

Integrity Error -40062 (1 of 2)

- Error Message
 - For each day that there is a Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) provided, a SPED need must be reported.
- Common Issues
 - The LRE entry/exit dates do not align with the Need(s) entry/exit dates.
 - Enrollment data may be missing.
- Possible Solution
 - All LRE dates must have a need reported.
 - Confirm that accurate entry and exit dates for Need(s) and LRE(s) are reported.
 - Check SPED99 SPED Orphan Data Report to ensure that all reported SPED data has a corresponding enrollment reported.

Integrity Error -40062 (2 of 2)

SPED99: SPED Orphan Data Report

SPED records reported to AzEDS that are not associated with an Enrollment. This disassociation commonly occurs when Enrollments are deleted and SPED data remains, typically resulting in concurrency errors. Consult your Student Information System vendor with the Source IDs below to remove the data.

Integrity Error -40079 (1 of 3)

- Error Message
 - Resident School ID must be within the District of Residence.
- Common Issues
 - Resident School ID is not a site of the District of Residence.
- Possible Solution
 - Validate the Resident School ID is reported using the SPED10 report.
 - Contact your SIS vendor if unsure where this data is reported in your SIS.
 - Element is identified in the AzEDS API as: StudentEducationOrganizationResponsibilityAssociation

Integrity Error -40079 (2 of 3)

Integrity Error -40079 (3 of 3)

- Exceptions to the Resident School ID being a site of the District of Residence
 - Students residing in an Elementary District without a high school and attending a High School or Union District, the resident school ID should be a site of the District of Attendance (DOA).
 - Students residing in a Transportation District, the resident school ID should be a site of the District of Attendance (DOA).
 - Students placed in an RTC with 9-12 grade **and** Home School District is identified as K-8, the resident school ID should be an elementary site of the Home School District.




