Specifically, the units of measurement for portion sizes were consistently inaccurate for the entrées served at breakfast and lunch listing Recorded Webinar & Webinar Slides measurements used for crediting (ounce equivalents) and weight (ounces) when the portion sizes were measured in volume (cups or under the Online Training Library fluid ounces).
