Specifically, daily vegetable quanities were not met at lunch from March 18-22, 2024. This was not determined to be a repeat finding from the previous cycle and therefore did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

### Meal Access & Reimbursement: Certification and Benefit Issuance

- The benefit issuance document did not accurately reflect method of certification. Specifically, 1 student matched in Medicaid free, but was recorded on the benefit issuance document as extended foster.
- Direct certification matches were not conducted according the proper time frames, which is at least once at or around the beginning of the school year, three months after the initial effort and six months after the initial effort). Specifcally, direct cerfication remained inactive for 119 days.
