Error Message:

SPED Need Developmental Delay (DD) must be Primary.

Description:

SPED Need Developmental Delay (DD) must be reported as the Federal Primary Need.

Example:

- SPED
 - Need(s)
 - Primary Student Need Indicator (Primary Need)
 - Start Date
 - End Date

 - Is DD reported as Primary Need?
 - o Are the dates correct?
 - Needs adhere to Eligibility Matrix?

Relevant AzEDS Portal Reports for Troubleshooting:

- SPED72
- SPED10

Troubleshooting:

- Review requirements for reporting DD need.
 - o Verify student is less than 10 years old.
 - Review the Concurrent Need Eligibility Matrix found on AzEDS SPED Reporting page.
- Review the SPED72 report to see the data used to process integrity.
 - Verify that DD is reported as the Primary Need.
 - o Verify that a single Primary Need exists for the date range that DD is reported.
 - Check the start and end dates for all reported need(s) and LRE(s).
- Verify that the information in your student information system (SIS) is correct.
 - Make corrections to DD, Primary Need, and dates as needed.
 - After syncing to AzEDS, review the SPED10 report to view incoming data.
 - Check INTEG15 and/or SPED72 report for updates to integrity the following day.
