Error Message:

SPED Need Multiple Disabilities (MD) or Multiple Disabilities Severe Sensory Impairment (MDSSI) must be Primary.

Description:

SPED Need Multiple Disabilities (MD) or Multiple Disabilities Severe Sensory Impairment (MDSSI) must be reported as the Federal Primary Need.

Troubleshooting:

- Review the Criteria for MD and MDSSI needs.
- Review the SPED72 report to see the data used to process integrity.
 - Verify that MD or MDSSI is reported as the Primary Need.
 - Verify that a single Primary Need exists for the date range that MD or MDSSI is reported.
 - Check the start and end dates for all reported need(s) and LRE(s).
- Verify that information is correct in your Student Information System.
 - o Make corrections to SPED need(s), LRE(s), the Primary Need, and dates as needed.
 - Verify that needs adhere to the Concurrent Need Eligibility Matrix
 - o After syncing to AzEDS, review the SPED10 report to check incoming data.
 - o Check INTEG15 and/or SPED72 report for updates to integrity the following day.
- If necessary, contact your student information system (SIS) vendor for guidance on reporting SPED needs and LREs.
