Transmitted herewith is the Fiscal Year 2024 Quarter 4 report of the Arizona Department of Education, Empowerment Scholarship Account program, conducted pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes §15-2406.

In completing this report, we discovered an error in the Fiscal Year 2024 Quarter 3 report that we previously issued on May 31, 2024. In that report's Table 2, on page 2, we over reported universal-eligibility students who attended a public school immediately prior to ESA enrollment in fiscal-year-to-date 2024 by 2,691 students. As a result, we also reported that 61.5 percent of universal-eligibility students enrolling in fiscal year 2024 through Quarter 3 had attended a public school immediately prior to ESA enrollment. That percentage should have been 47.5 percent in Quarter 3. That is similar to the 47.6 percent we are reporting for Quarter 4. We have updated the report posted on our website to reflect the corrected information.

Arizona Empowerment Scholarship Account Program Fiscal Year 2024—Quarter 4 Report to Executive and Legislative Leadership

Key points

- **Nearly three-quarters of ESA students participate under universal eligibility**—74,578 students received an Empowerment Scholarship in Quarter 4 and were eligible in 1 of 11 eligibility categories.
 - 74.5 percent participated under *universal* eligibility
 - 18 percent were *students with a disability*, which is higher than the almost 14 percent in district public schools
 - Almost 7.5 percent participated in 1 of the other 8 eligibility categories
- **Increasing number of universal-eligibility students are coming from public schools immediately prior to ESA participation**—Of universal-eligibility students in grades 1-12 enrolling in the ESA program in fiscal year 2024, 47.6 percent of them attended public school immediately prior to enrolling in the ESA program. This is almost a 27 percentage-point increase over the number of ESA students in grades 1-12 who attended public school immediately prior to enrolling in the ESA program last year, in fiscal year 2023.
- **Majority of ESA students with a disability have autism**—In Quarter 4, almost 7,100, or nearly 53 percent, of the 13,446 ESA students with a disability had an autism diagnosis.
- **Majority of ESA scholarships are between \$7,000 and \$8,000**—52 percent of the 74,578 ESA students on the program in Quarter 4 had annual scholarships between \$7,000 and \$8,000.
- **The total annual scholarship awards for students enrolled in Quarter 4 was \$738,002,994.**
- **Nearly half a million items and services purchased by ESA families were processed by the ESA program in Quarter 4.**

Introduction

In accordance with Title 15, Chapter 19, Article 1 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, the Arizona Department of Education and the Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) program present this quarterly report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Director of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, and the Director of the Governor's Office of Strategic Planning and Budgeting. This report reflects data and information from Quarter 4 of fiscal year 2024, covering April 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024. As stipulated in Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §15-2406, this report includes the following:

1. The number of qualified students disaggregated by:

(a) Eligibility category

(b) For qualified students who are eligible pursuant to section 15-2401.01, the number of qualified students who attended a public school in this state in the school year immediately preceding the first year of each qualified student's enrollment in the Arizona empowerment scholarship account program

² Table 4 captures the school districts and charter schools that ESA students in all eligibility categories attended immediately prior to enrolling in the ESA program. However, this information is only reported from fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2024—Quarter 4. It does not cover the period from fiscal years 2011 (when the ESA program was first implemented) through 2016. In fiscal year 2017, the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) implemented a new student information system (SIS). Because of the risks of relying on student level data from 8 fiscal years earlier that were migrated from another SIS, we chose only to report on data beginning in fiscal year 2017 for the purposes of this report.

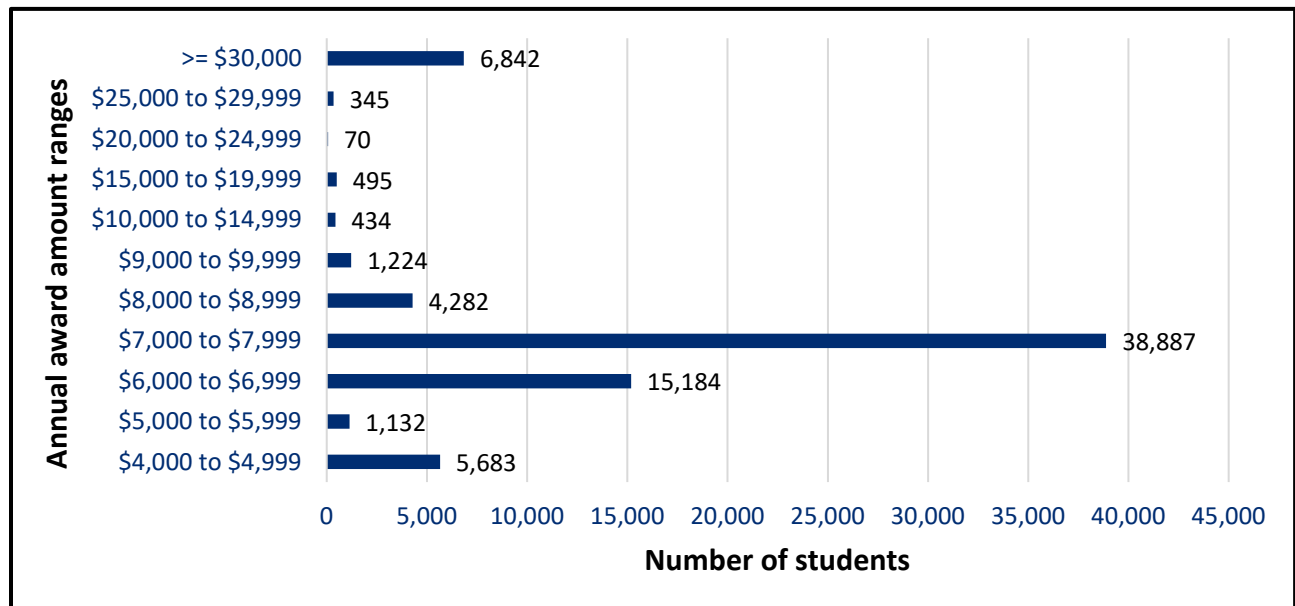

However, ClassWallet does not capture ESA Account Holders' spending on an item level when they spend their funds through "Pay Vendor", seek reimbursements, or use a ClassWallet-issued debit card. When ESA Holders spend their ESA funds through these 3 options, ClassWallet currently only captures data on an order level. For this reason, Marketplace spending, which can be captured on an item level, is separated from spending through the other options.

⁵ Although items purchased by ESA Holders through the ClassWallet Marketplace were captured by ClassWallet on an item level, when there was more than 1 item on an order, and the items on the order were for different expense categories, the expense categories were not captured on an item level for a portion of Quarter 4.
