Lunch production records and menus do not accurately reflect what is being served. Specifically, the Lunch production record for May reflect what food components are served. 30, 2024 indicated a fruit was served but did not name what specific fruit was served.

Discussed posted menus and completed production records should accurately

- 10 The crediting information recorded on the lunch production record is inaccurate. Specifically, the Salad served at Gila Bend High School on May 30, 2024 credited as 1.25 cups of other vegetables; however, the production record indicated it credited as 0.50 cup of dark green vegetables. In addition, the Gala Apple served on May 31, 2024 credited as 1 cup of fruit; however, the production record indicated it credited as 0.50 cup of fruit.
- 11 Separate production records were not kept by site. Specifically, one production record was used to document for all meals served at Gila Bend High School and Gila Bend Elementary School.
