ACT Aspire – Grades 9 (Cohort 2028)

- ✓ Available online and paper-based
- ✓ Timed test sections: English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing
- Test sections may be administered in any order, all in one test day or over multiple test days.

- ✓ Hard copies of manuals will not be sent manuals are online only.
- ✓ Special Paper Version (Braille, large print, regular print) and accommodations for American Sign Language or Speech-to-Text: Submit to ADE for approval
- ✓ A non-branded scientific calculator is embedded in online test (Math only)

ACT – Grade 11 (Cohort 2026)

- ✓ Available online and paper-based
- ✓ Timed test sections: English, Math, Reading, Science, and Writing
- ✓ Test sections **must** be administered in the order listed above.
- ✓ Testing must be completed in one day unless student has received an ACT-approved accommodation for testing over multiple days.
- ✓ Schools may utilize both test windows in order to assess all students.

- Hard copies of manuals will be sent.
- ✓ Accommodations requests must be submitted to ACT in the ACT Test Accessibility & Accommodations (TAA) system.
- ✓ ACT is the high school requirement for ELA and Math. Cohort 2026 students must also take AzSCI as the high school Science requirement.
- ✓ Desmos Graphing Calculator is embedded in online test.

AzSCI - Grade 11 (Cohort 2026)

- ✓ Online Science assessment
- ✓ Three test units, estimated at 60-90 minutes each
- ✓ Test is untimed

- ✓ Desmos Scientific Calculator is embedded in online test.
- Assessing Essential Standards in physical science, earth science, and life science for high school
