Trending Topics: ODC Phase I Webinar (1 of 2)

- Run frequent data reports. Communicate with your staff. Keep integrity clean.
- Keep a separate spreadsheet for your Oct I count that is not an ADE Report. This will be your working spreadsheet that can be manipulated. It helps.
- Review data as often as you can up to the due date.
- Take your time and go through your data thoroughly.
- Talk with registrars and teachers on-site to ensure all students are identified and reported.

Trending Topics: ODC Phase I Webinar (2 of 2)

- Take your time and attend this training.
- Don't wait until the day of to get counts. Start your lists early and crosscheck weekly!
- AzEDS should not be used to get student information since the data could not be fully updated.
- Make sure you remind IT and registrars not to touch any SPED students prior to the Phase I due date unless they discuss it with the SPED Director once the count has been submitted.
- Do not submit on Oct 1. Wait for the dust to settle. Submit later but in time for the deadline :)

- Review Integrity Tool -40040
- Collaborate with concurrent PEA
- Determine correct LRE dates for student
- Applicable PEA to make corrections
- If done correctly, the integrity error should clear

SPED99 Report Action Steps for -40057

- Review Integrity Tool -40057
- Verify accurate reporting of LRE dates for primary Main SPED school
- Integrity error will contain the name of concurrent PEA
- Collaborate with other PEA
- Determine if enrollment was deleted, but SPED remained
- Other PEA deletes SPED

 ESS Data Management AzEDS SPED Reporting

Integrity Error -4005

Error Message:

One or more schools have been identified as the Main school providing special education. Please contact (Actual1) to determine which school(s) have concurrently reported the Main SPED School Indicator.

{Actual1} – This will show the concurrent DORs in the error message on the INTEG15 report

Description:

If a student has a concurrent Main SPED School Indicator of primary at multiple schools, then report the discrepancy as an error. Note that multiple schools may report Main SPED School Indicator of secondary.

Troubleshooting

- Verify your PEA is reporting the correct entry and exit dates.
- Check your INTEG15 report in the AzEDS Portal.
- The error message will contain the names of the concurrent PEAs
- Check your SPED50 report in the AzEDS Portal.
 - This report will contain the relevant concurrent data to aid in collaboration Contact the other PEA to collaborate and correct dates
- If the error message only shows your PEA one of two issues may be happening:
 You have two Primary LREs reported that are overlapping. Check your SPED72 and
- SPED50 reports to ensure all SPED Primary LREs reported do not overlap.
 Another PEA may have deleted their enrollment and the SPED data remains, defined as 'Orphan Data'. Contact <u>ESSDataMgmt@azed.gov</u> to inquire if this is the case. The PEA with 'Orphan Data' can use the SPED99 report to identify and remove the data.

(Last updated: October 26, 2023)

 Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72 report. Continue to follow up with other PEA if change has not been made.

The SPED72 report will show all students reported to AzEDS with SPED needs and/or SPED Program participation, ELL participation, and whether they have passed FED SPED and State SPED integrity.

Identify Your Errors (slide 2 of 2)

Check your INTEG15 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The INTEG15 report displays a post-integrity list of student data related to membership and their integrity status results. Drill down using the filters to identify students at a specific site (optional), Integrity Status as 'Failed,' and Integrity Category of 'SPED' and 'Fed SPED.'

Integrity Error -40031

- Error Message
 - Site is not approved to provide this need code or is not approved within reported dates. If private placement, refer to Approved Private School lists.
- Common Issues
 - Site does not have need active during given timeframe.
- Possible Solution
 - For preschools and head starts, contact ESS Data Management
 - For all others, be sure to review the Approved Private School list found on the Private Special Education Schools page.

Integrity Error -40048

- Error Message
 - Student must have a Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) with a start date > the latest exit date of a SPED Exit code 9.
- Common Issues
 - The LRE does not have a start date greater than the latest exit date of LRE with a SPED Exit code 9
- Possible Solution
 - Verify correct use of SPED09 exit code
 - Review SPED72 report for student's LRE entry and exit dates.

Integrity Error -40004

- Error Message
 - The Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) code, grade, or need combination does not comply with the Concurrent Need and Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Code Eligibility matrix.
 - <u>Concurrent Need and LRE Code Eligibility Matrix</u>
- Common Issues
 - Rollover from PS to Kindergarten
- Possible Solution
 - Review SPED72 for KG students
 - Contact your SIS vendor for assistance with PS to KG rollover process
