- Discussed that when local officials for delinguent debt are useless or too costly, the debt must be reclassified as uncollectable accounts and related collection and legal costs arising from such debts after they have been determined to be uncollectable are unallowable. Therefore, the nonprofit school food service account may not be used to cover these costs.
