AZTRAP	 Apprentices participate in a registered apprenticeship program that earns them all criteria necessary to become a certified classroom educator in the state of Arizona Apprentices receive hands-on classroom experience for a minimum of two years under the guidance of a mentor teacher Apprentices "earn-and-learn' as full-time employees
Benefits for EPPs	 Increases enrollment by lowering cost through unlocking United States Department of Labor funding sources EPPs can develop valuable partnerships with LEAs that fosters growth for both parties EPPs can expand their network of working professionals in the field
EPP Responsibilities	 Provide classroom instruction and program that leads to state certification Design course workload for apprentices who must be working full-time Partner with LEAs to fulfill working experience requirements into the apprentice's full-time work experience Report on the progress of the apprentice bi-annually with LEA to ensure all data is up to date
