

Getting Started in the AzLMS

This document outlines how an Achievement District Test Coordinator gets started in the Arizona Learning Management System (AzLMS)

- 1. You will receive an email inviting you to create an account.
 - a. The email comes from: admin@adobelearningmanager.com
 - b. The email subject is: Welcome to Arizona's Learning Management System: Verification required.
 - i. You may need to check your Spam/Junk folder.
 - ii. If you cannot find the email, contact Testing@azed.gov.
 - 1. Include in the email: Your first and last name, your email address, request to have welcome email resent.
- 2. Follow the steps in the email to create your Adobe account.
- 3. Complete Using the LMS Learner Portal module and Managing Learners in the LMS module.
 - a. Download the .pdf resources for reference.
- 4. Invite your learners to set-up their Adobe account.
 - a. Your welcome email contains links for your learners.
 - b. You need to share role associated links with the appropriate learners.
 - c. Ask your learners to complete the **Using the LMS Learner Portal** module.
 - d. If you cannot see your learner(s) they either have not created their account yet, or they chose the wrong district when registering.

- i. If learners chose the wrong district, they would need to contact
 Testing@azed.gov and request a registration correction.
 - 1. Include in the email: Learner's first and last name, learner's email address, learner's correct district and school.
- 5. Which courses should you complete?
 - a. Use the <u>Training Requirements</u> document to understand which courses are required for each role.
 - i. This can be found three different ways:
 - 1. Select **Learn More** on the revolving home page banner.
 - 2. Select **Training Requirements** from the footer of your home page.
 - Launch the Training Requirements module that lives in your Achievement Testing catalog.
 - **b.** We strongly suggest learners self-enroll in courses by selecting the **LMS Training** catalog.
 - i. The Using the LMS Learner Portal module will teach learners how to enroll.
 - ii. The Managing Learners in the LMS module will teach DTCs how to enroll learners in their courses.
