- •Expansion Schools with existing Entity and CTDS identification numbers:
 - ✓ approval to expand your school's grades,
 - \checkmark what grades you are expanding, or,
 - \checkmark if this is a new school site, what grades will you serve.
- •School Finance will walk you through the EOS process.
