ADE/ESS State Performance Plan

Indicator 8 Parent Involvement Survey

The survey measures the percentage of parents with a child receiving special education services who **report that schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results** for children with disabilities.

Online Survey Application

Survey Portal: <u>https://ADEParentSurvey.azed.gov</u>

The short, online-only survey can be completed in less than ten minutes on a computer, tablet, or smartphone.

Users are prompted to choose English or Spanish. Each unique, **confidential**, login code provides demographic information about the student from AzEDS.

Survey Questions (slide 1 of 3)

Likert scale questions (Strongly Agree, Agree, Disagree, Strongly Disagree, Not Applicable)

- I work together with the IEP team as an equal partner to develop my or my child's IEP.
- 2. I feel comfortable telling my ideas about how well special education services meet my or my child's needs.
- 3. The teacher(s) keep(s) in touch with me regularly about my or my child's progress.

Survey Questions (slide 2 of 3)

- 4. My relationship with the school staff has a positive effect on my or my child's education.
- 5. Administrators are available to discuss my questions or concerns.
- 6. My school helps me play an active role in my or my child's education.
- 7. The school explains what choices I have if we disagree.

Survey Questions (slide 3 of 3)

- 8. Overall, I am satisfied with how my or my child's school makes it easy for me to be involved.
- 9. How does your school encourage you to be involved?
 - Questions 1—8 are always confidential.
 - Question 9 is an open-ended question that will be confidential unless a student or a specific situation is identified.

ADEConnect Data Collection

- Survey is open January 20 through May 31, 2025
 - October 1 census list generates unique student login codes
 - Districts survey parents of their private day/tuitionedout students
 - ✓ Students over 18 take the survey unless a parent has retained IEP rights

Identify Your Errors (slide 1 of 2)

Check your SPED72 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The SPED72 report will show all students reported to AzEDS with SPED needs and/or SPED Program participation, ELL participation, and whether they have passed FED SPED and State SPED integrity.

Identify Your Errors (slide 2 of 2)

Check your INTEG15 Report in the AzEDS Portal

The INTEG15 report displays a post-integrity list of student data related to membership and their integrity status results. Drill down using the filters to identify students at a specific site (optional), Integrity Status as 'Failed,' and Integrity Category of 'SPED' and 'Fed SPED.'

Integrity Error <u>-40076</u>

- Error Message
 - SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Exit Date with Exit Code SPED13 must only be reported on the last in-session day of the reported calendar
- Description
 - When a student's SPED LRE is reported with SPED13 Exit Code (School is Out), the exit date must be the last in-session day of the reported calendar for that school site
- Possible Solution
 - Review AzEDS calendar and default SPED and enrollment dates in your SIS.

Integrity Error <u>-40077</u>

- Error Message
 - Missing Resident School ID for SPED LRE reported
- Description
 - When a student SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) is reported a Resident School ID must be reported
- Possible Solution
 - Contact vendor to identify element location for StudentEducationOrganizationResponsibilityAssociation.
 - Update ResidentSchoolID to the site student would normally attend within your district.

Integrity Error <u>-40057</u>

- Error Message
 - One or more schools have been identified as the Main school providing special education. Please contact {Actual1} to determine which school(s) have concurrently reported the Main SPED School Indicator. {Actual1} – This will show the concurrent DORs in the error message on the INTEG15 report.
- Description
 - If a student has a concurrent Main SPED School Indicator of primary at multiple schools, then report the discrepancy as an error. Note that multiple schools may report Main SPED School Indicator of secondary
- Possible Solution
 - Verify LRE dates.
 - Check SPED50 Report
 - Contact Data Management.
