Q: If we have been doing FFVP all these years do we have to apply or does our application just transfer to the following year?

A: School Food Authorities (SFAs) must apply for the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP) annually.

Q: Normally I've seen catalogs due in myFoods in March. Is it now April?
