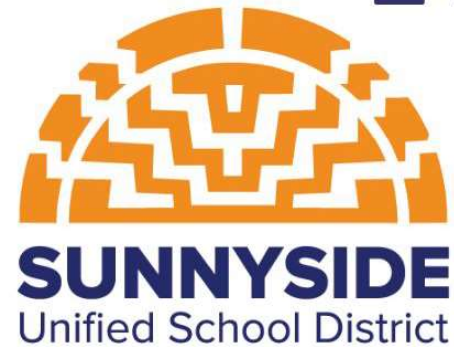

Current funding & spending remains on track

FY25 July 1, 2024 - September 30, 2025

- Title I Allocation = \$7,196,924.69
- Title II Allocation = \$793,378.91

# Future Funding Allocations

Projected budgets and grant applications for FY26 (2025-2025 school year) will be available on **April 1, 2025** (prior years March 1)

## Allocations impacted by:

- **Poverty Counts - Census Bureau**  
(AZ had slight increase)
- **District Enrollment**
- **Increase in # of Charter Schools**
- **Changes at the Federal level**

## **Preliminary Allocations for next year:**

FY26 July 1, 2025 - September 30, 2026

Title I Allocation = 20% decrease

*This amount will be updated based on federal budget once passed.*

Title II Allocation = ??



# Next Steps

We are moving forward with Federal requirements:

- Schools are conducting Comprehensive Needs Assessments (CNA) and building Integrated Action Plans (IAP) in preparation for the upcoming school year.
- District Level Integrated Action Plan
- Private School Consultations - enrollment holding steady
- Tribal Consultations
