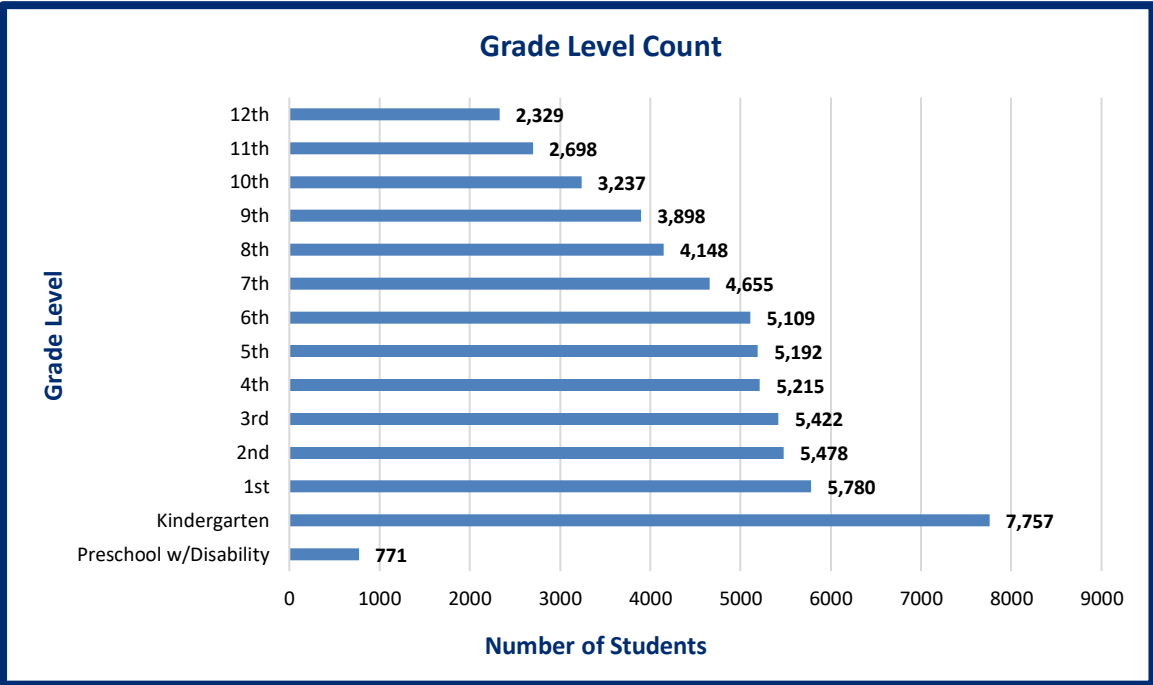
In accordance with Article 15 Empowerment Scholarship Accounts, Rule 7-2-1503 (5) and (6) under the Department Responsibilities, the Arizona Department of Education’s Empowerment Scholarship Account Program presents this quarterly report to the Arizona State Board of Education. 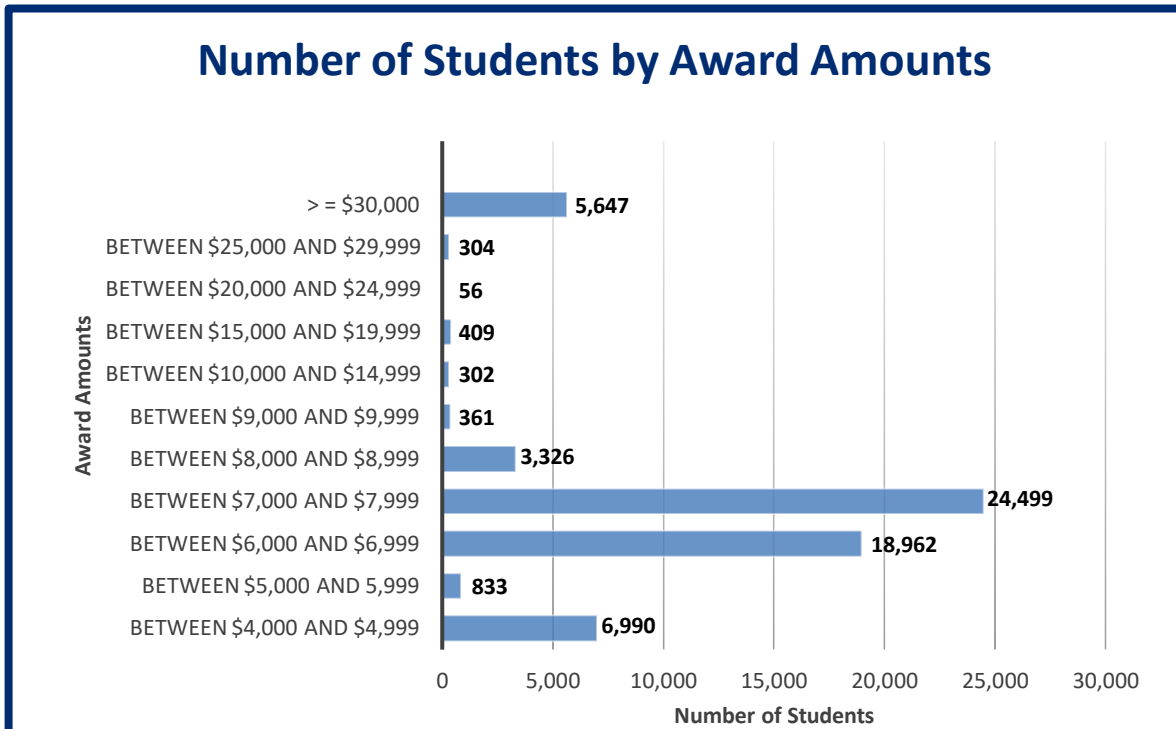

All ESA applications for enrollment are reviewed by an ESA employee and an ESA special investigator audits applications on a risk basis to ensure that all eligibility information presented is valid and true.

All purchases are reviewed by one or more ESA or ClassWallet employee to ensure that purchases are allowable. Approved purchases are further audited on a random and risk basis by an ESA employee to ensure the validity of approved purchases.

(l) Provide data related to Help Desk Tickets, including:

- i. **The quantity of HelpDesk tickets not responded to within 3 business days:**

ESA HelpDesk ticket system currently does not have the functionality to produce reports that show the response time for each HelpDesk ticket in the system. At this point in time, the ESA HelpDesk ticket system can only produce summary level statistics. As a result, we can report that, on average, HelpDesk tickets were responded to in 8 days.

- ii. **The quantity of HelpDesk tickets prematurely closed and reopened.**

The ESA programs current practice is that every item purchased with ESA funds is reviewed by an ESA or ClassWallet employee. All purchases that are rejected by a Purchase Review Specialist because they are determined to be unallowable are then reviewed by a second ESA employee, which often includes a supervisor, to evaluate whether the purchase is in fact unallowable.

For purchases that are approved by a Purchase Review Specialist as allowable, they are subject to random reviews by a Purchase Review Lead Specialist, who audits whether the purchase was correctly approved.

As a result of all purchases being reviewed by 1 or more ESA employees, every purchase is audited for appropriateness.

- iii. **A.R.S. §15-2403(B): The Department shall also conduct or contract for random, quarterly and annual audits of Arizona empowerment scholarship accounts as needed to ensure compliance with section § 15- 2402, subsection B, paragraph 4.**

In fiscal year 2023, Quarter 4, the Department of Education posted a Request for Proposal (RFP) on May 19, 2023 to solicit proposals from bidders to conduct independent third party evaluations of qualified students to determine eligibility to receive educational therapies or services pursuant to A.R.S. 15-2403(J)(B)(4)(c). However, the Department cancelled the RFP on August 15, 2023 in the best interest of the State, because it was determined by statute that the contract must be competitively awarded to a single contractor. The RFP posted on May 19, 2023 allowed for multiple contractors to be awarded contracts, which necessitated its cancellation.

The Department of Education is currently in the process of developing an RFP to address this statutory requirement. We expect to have the RFP completed and posted by the end of the current quarter.
